As so often happens in the Care Industry we have had staff move on or retire recently. However we are happy to report that new staff members have joined the team bringing our staffing level up to our requirements.

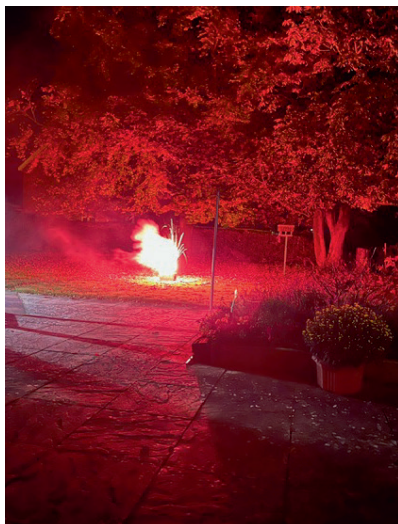
Please pray for the ongoing work and the needs of the Trust and all who live at Quebec Hall.

Legion d'Honneur awarded to the late Reginald Lewis



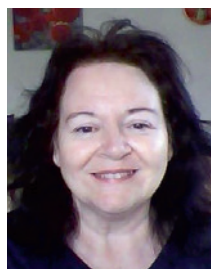
On January 28th this year, General, the Lord Dannatt, retired head of the British Army, made this presentation on behalf of the French Government.

Our thanks must also go to Lynne, Carol, David and Mark for their help on the evening.

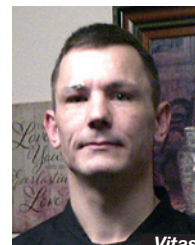


STAFF NEWS...

They take up their roles as kitchen assistant's/cook and carers. We pray they will settle in quickly and enjoy their time working at Quebec Hall.



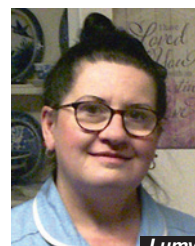
